

DO'S and DON'TS of LIFE

Today, Jesus shares an inspiring pep talk with His disciples about the do's and don'ts of life (Lk 6:17, 20-26). As they embark on their ministry, Jesus knows that things may become chaotic sometimes, and He genuinely wants them to maintain their focus. He highlights what truly matters: the do's and don'ts of life. We often find ourselves in the tricky situation of saying one thing while our actions indicate something different. We express our beliefs, yet sometimes, we get caught up in thinking that life's ultimate goal is to gather wealth, find fulfillment, avoid problems, and/or evade negative experiences. Jesus recognized this prideful temptation, so He didn't begin by discussing the perks or tactics of following Him. Instead, He lovingly emphasizes the fundamental do's and don'ts of life. First, regarding the do's, He encourages them to be blessed by being poor in spirit, hungering for the Lord, finding strength in weeping, and rejoicing in the face of challenges. Second, concerning the don'ts, He gently advises them not to chase after wealth, become overly satisfied, or take joy in pointing out others' faults. The more we embrace Jesus' do's and don'ts, the easier it becomes to resist temptation. Jesus understands that amidst our daily challenges, the disciples and all of us must keep our eyes on what truly matters. Let's strive for our words and actions to reflect the beautiful do's and don'ts that Jesus teaches us about life.




ACS Donates Water to Loaves and Fishes
