BEING ABLE TO HEAR DIFFERENTLY

After Jesus healed the deaf man with the speech impediment, the man was able to hear differently (Mk 7: 31-37). One can only imagine how excited he must have been after being healed. He could communicate differently. He could see others differently. He could treat others differently. I believe that we all could be the deaf man with speech impediments. We can talk with people, work with people, visit with them every day, and not really see them or hear them for who they are. You could sit across from someone in Church and not truly see them. You could know someone for years and not truly know them. These days, many neighbors don't even speak to one another. It is easy to be deaf to those around us, to be impeded in truly being able to communicate with them because we are not really "hearing" them. Like the deaf man, we must constantly throw ourselves before the Lord's healing presence. We must throw ourselves before the Lord in our daily prayers, through the Sacraments, and through learning more about our faith. For it is when we place ourselves before the Lord that He can speak those most beautiful words to us - "Ephphatha," that is, "Be Open." When your ears, and heart and soul are "opened," it is then that you can relate to others on a much deeper level. It is then that you start getting to know those around you as God knows them, sees them, and is working in and through them. Let us step up and do the daily work that it takes to really "hear" those around us in a very different way?






