

GREED vs CHARITY

Greed can be seen as an overwhelming desire to have more, whether wealth, possessions, or even more power. This desire becomes harmful when it affects ourselves or others. Jesus faced the temptation of greed during his time in the desert, where he was tempted three times- first by physical desires, then by power, and finally to impress others (Lk 4:1-13). Out of his deep love for God the Father, Jesus turned away from the devil's greedy temptations, choosing instead to embrace the virtue of charity. When we face greed with charity, it loses its hold on us, especially when we instinctively give ourselves freely to the Lord and to others without expecting anything in return. Charity is all about generously serving others and is a powerful force encouraging us to set aside our greed. Like Jesus, charity invites us to prioritize our love for God and those around us, putting our desires on the back burner. We keep the spirit of charity alive when we dedicate time for personal prayer, give generously to the Church and those in need, spend quality moments with loved ones, listen more than we speak, and lend a hand to those who need it. Jesus thwarted the devil's temptations through the gift of charity. Let's follow his example and embrace charity wholeheartedly, sharing a love for God and each other that comes with no strings attached.

Go to Confession: If you haven't in a while, now is a great time to reconnect with God through the sacrament of reconciliation.


Remember, Lent is about transformation, not perfection. Let's walk this journey together!




