

#### WHAT'S ON YOUR PLAYLIST?

In the past, a playlist was defined by the records stored on a shelf, then it was CD collections or MP3 downloads. Now our playlist is tagged with songs on Spotify, Pandora, Apple Music, etc..... What about your "Faith Playlist?" What scripture passages, songs, bible studies, or spiritual reading have you collected? Are you constantly renewing, restoring, replacing, and rebooting your Catholic Faith - "Faith Playlist"? The reality is that as we continue to grow closer to the Lord that, "indeed the word of God is living and effective, sharper than any two-edged sword, penetrating even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to discern reflections and thoughts of the heart" (Heb. 4:12). How are you strengthening your faith? What Catholic podcasts are you listening to? What videos or eBooks from FORMED are you taking advantage of? What do you go to MyParishApp to explore? In today's gospel reading, the disciples thought that following the 10 commandments was enough (old playlist). Jesus let the disciples know quickly they were just getting started. "Giving up everything," or other words, putting God first above everything and everyone else in their lives (Mk 10: 17-30), was what was most important (new playlist). What should you add to your "Faith Playlist"? Maybe a little extra quiet time, reading the scriptures, studying the Catechism, coming to Adult Faith Formation, making sure your children are in Parish School of Religion, attending Mass more often, going to Eucharistic Adoration once a month, being a greater steward with your money, spiritual reading, assisting at Mass, praying the rosary, going to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, being kinder to those around you, etc.... Jesus didn't promise that it would be easy. He did promise that any spiritual sacrifices would be blessed 100-fold. What's on your "Faith Playlist"?




