THE SOURCE OF TRUE POWER

Where does the source of our true power originate? Money? Control? Position? Jesus Christ? In John 18: 33b-37, Pilate believes that true power comes from his position of influence. Pilate lived in all his finery while possessing political and military power. Yet, standing before him, shackled and helpless, is Jesus, who says that his power comes from "testifying to the truth." What is his truth? Jesus' truth is that the only effective and lasting power in the world is unselfish love. His truth is that he is a bound prisoner who loves others and will soon give his very life for everyone. His truth is that true power radiates from a simple, quiet, gentle, and persistent love that seeks to do good for others. Jesus' truth is that he desires to be vulnerable before God, sacrificial with his time, and forgiving from the depths of his heart. This truth, this form of love, requires us, at times, in quiet, gentle, and persistent ways to face our own Pilates. To face the Pilates in our lives that wield a limited, selfish power. A temporary power that is experienced through their sense of control, sharp tongues, and passive aggressive assaults. In their presence, we must wield a depth of love anchored in Christ, the very King of our lives. A love that compels us to be vulnerable, sacrificial, forgiving, and open – allowing ourselves to love and be loved by God's love. With this depth of love, we easily grow in discovering a newfound freedom. A freedom that allows us to trust a power greater than ourselves - the very power of God's unconditional love. Yes, we are to model Jesus Christ's quiet, gentle, and persistent love that makes Jesus Christ the most powerful King of our Lives.

When Jesus walked the earth, He chose not to forcibly impose His divine authority and rule upon nations, even though many of His followers wanted Him to do so. Instead, He instituted the Kingdom of God as a spiritual reality in which we are all called to voluntarily participate, for now. Those who do participate are called to work to establish Christ's Kingdom on earth, here and now, by governing according to the mind and will of God. The modern-day concept of the separation of Church and State is helpful insofar as the Church must be free from political interference and control. However, this separation should never lead to an exclusion of the King of

the Universe from human governance. Rather, human beings must give themselves over to the control and dominion of the Great King, and then govern according to His mind and will. Pope Pius XI goes on to say, "When once men recognize, both in private and in public life, that Christ is King, society will at last receive the great blessings of real liberty, well-ordered discipline, peace and harmony. Our Lord's regal office invests the human authority of princes and rulers with a religious significance; it ennobles the citizen's duty of obedience."



Our theatre program is fantastic here at ACS, and everything from the auditions to the performance is carefully planned. Keep an eye out for our musical performance on April 10th and 11th.




