

Twenty-First Sunday in **Ordinary Time**

BE SUBORDINATE

In his letter to the Ephesians, St. Paul gives a beautiful treatise on the Church and how we are called to be in a relationship with one another. St. Paul says, "Brothers and sisters: Be subordinate to one another out of reverence for Christ" (Ep 5: 21). For example, St. Paul points to married couples. The wife is called to be submissive to her husband, while the husband is called to sacrifice his very life for his wife. Both are called to give over everything, to be subordinate to one another; both equally give everything to the other. Approaching everyday life with those around us in the same spirit becomes the challenge. How are we subordinate, secondary or lesser than the person next to us? Couples do it all the time in their marriage. Parents naturally put their wants aside to do for their children. Teachers are constantly humbling themselves for their students, and students are humbling themselves when obeying their teachers. Some people find it easier to be subordinate than others. The key becomes in our attitude. Do we have the attitude to be intentionally submissive to those around us? Do we have the attitude to give our very lives for the average person around us? Do we have the attitude of giving whatever it takes in a given moment to help the other person increase as you decrease? In a world where people can be polarized in their approach toward politics, religion, gender and/or culture, we are reminded that each of us help make up the body of Christ. And in this body, there are some rules of engagement. We must "be subordinate to one another out of reverence for Christ" (Ep 5:21).
