

Sifting Through Your Words

In the first reading, the Prophet Sirach (Sir 27: 4-7) reminds us that we need to sift through our words and divide what is good from what is evil. Before we look to others and what they are doing wrong, our Lord teaches that we should start by "sifting" through our own words: the wooden beam in your eye impairs your vision in telling good from evil (Lk 6:39-45). St. Paul's letter to the Ephesians 4:29 teaches, "No foul language should come out of your mouths, but only such as is good for needed edification, that it may impart grace to those who hear". I know someone who had what they called the "swear jar". Every time they swore or said something unkind during the day, they would put a slip of paper in this jar. By the end of the week, they were horrified at how full the jar was. It became a reminder that they not only needed to change their vocabulary. They also needed to stop passive-aggressively talking about people behind their backs. A month later, they realized that sifting through their words made their thoughts and actions much more holy, loving, and just. When sifting through your words, take an inventory of your words and deeds and perhaps say a Hail Mary for every offense or anyone on the receiving end. After a couple of weeks of sifting through your words, you will respond very differently.








ACS Students Place High In Regional Science Fair




